



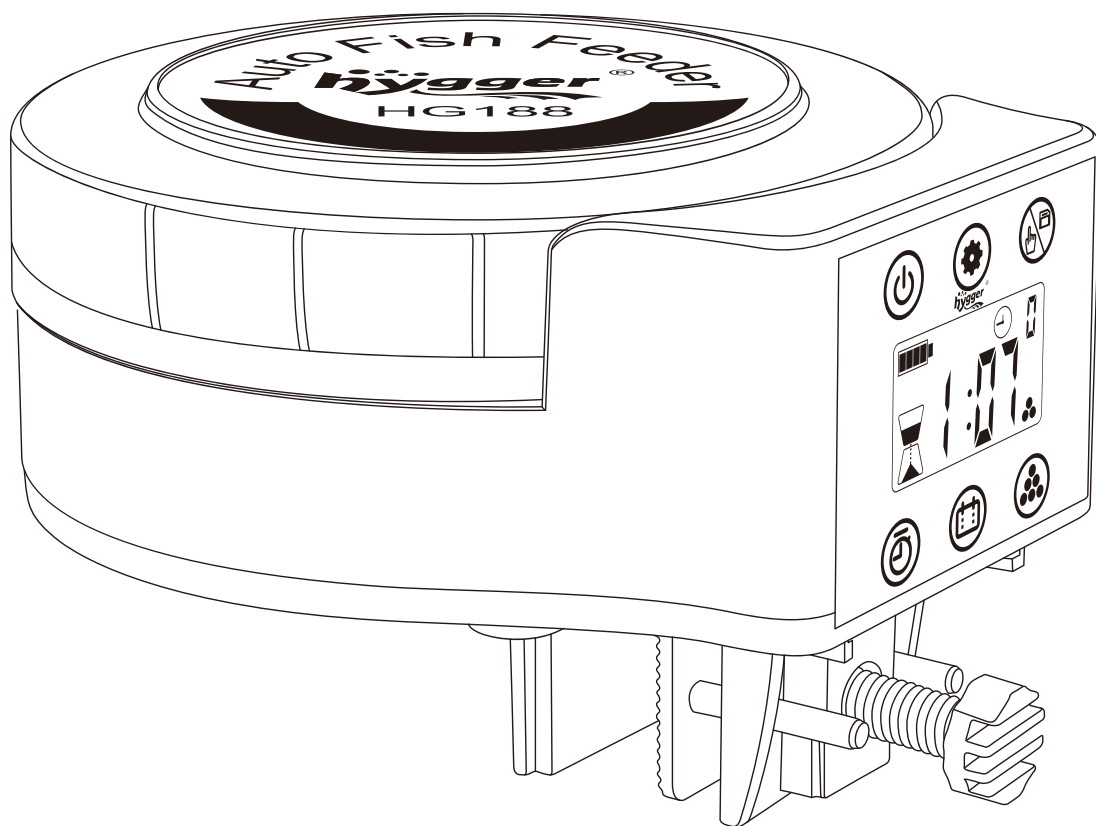

HG188 USER MANUAL

hygger Disc Automatic Fish Feeder



The hygger Disc Automatic Fish Feeder is controlled by an intelligent IC and is suitable for various aquarium sizes. It meets the requirements for daily feeding and transportation over long distances. Please read this user manual carefully before use and keep it for future reference; follow the instructions to ensure proper use.

1. PRODUCT FEATURES

- Built-in 3 No. 5 batteries, no external power supply.
- LCD display: Displays clock and feeding parameters
- You can synchronize the clock with the local time
- Precision feeding size (The maximum capacity of the cell is 7ml)
- Automatic fish feeding is scheduled up to 6 times daily, allowing you to set specific feeding times for each meal
- The amount of food per feeding can be freely adjusted from level 1 to level 9
- The previous feeding Settings are automatically saved after power failure.

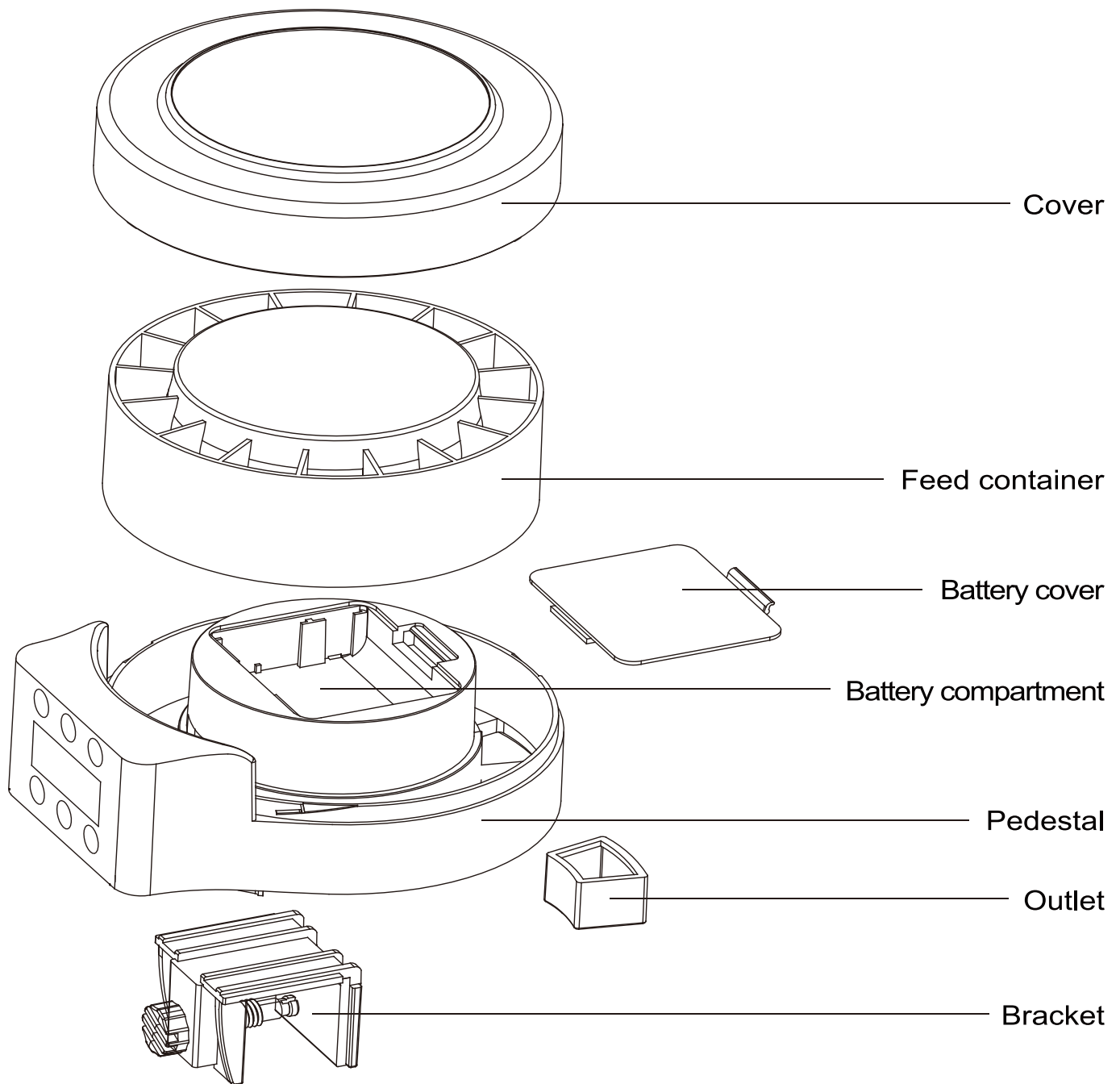

Please note: " - "means no feeding time is set, each serving size for feeding is standardized to a single unit, known as '1 lattice'.

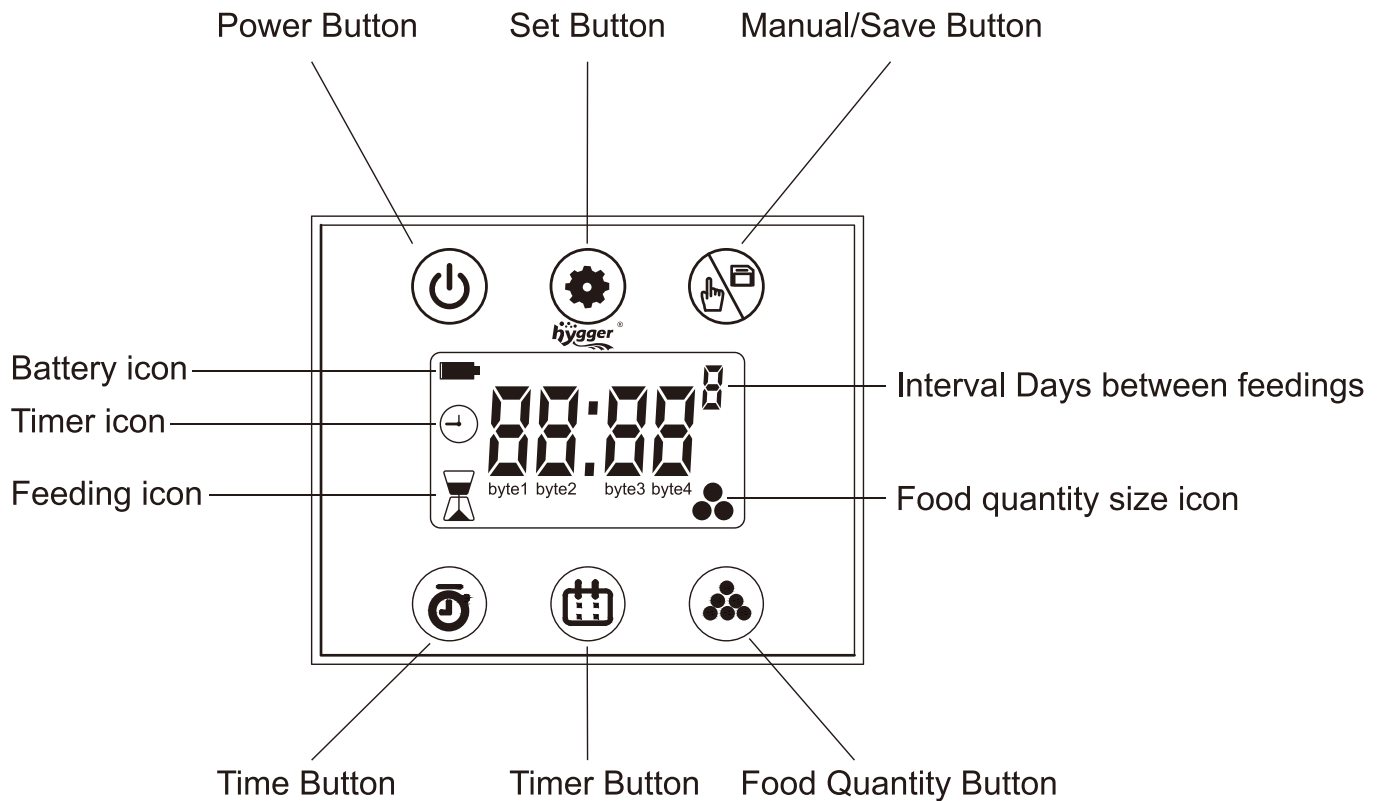
4. INSTALLATION INSTRUCTIONS



1) Installation:

- ① Install the bracket, and secure the adjustment knob to the aquarium glass edge, suitable for glass up to 15mm thick.
 - ② Install the feeder on the bracket using the suction cups.
- 2) To replace the battery, you need to disassemble the battery compartment.
- 3) Please readjust the local time after installing new batteries.
- 4) Open the hopper's top cover and pour in the feed.

5. CONTROL PANEL



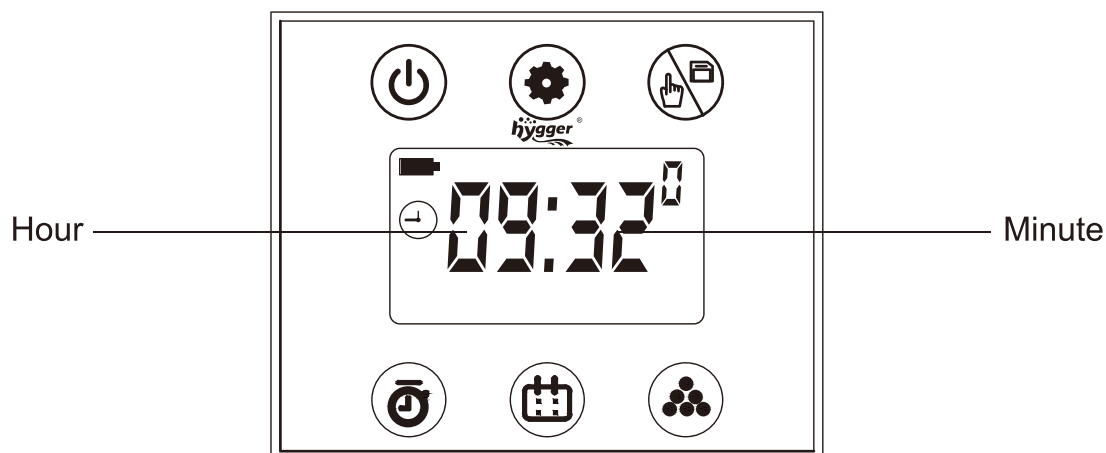
6. INSTRUCTIONS FOR USE

1) Turn On

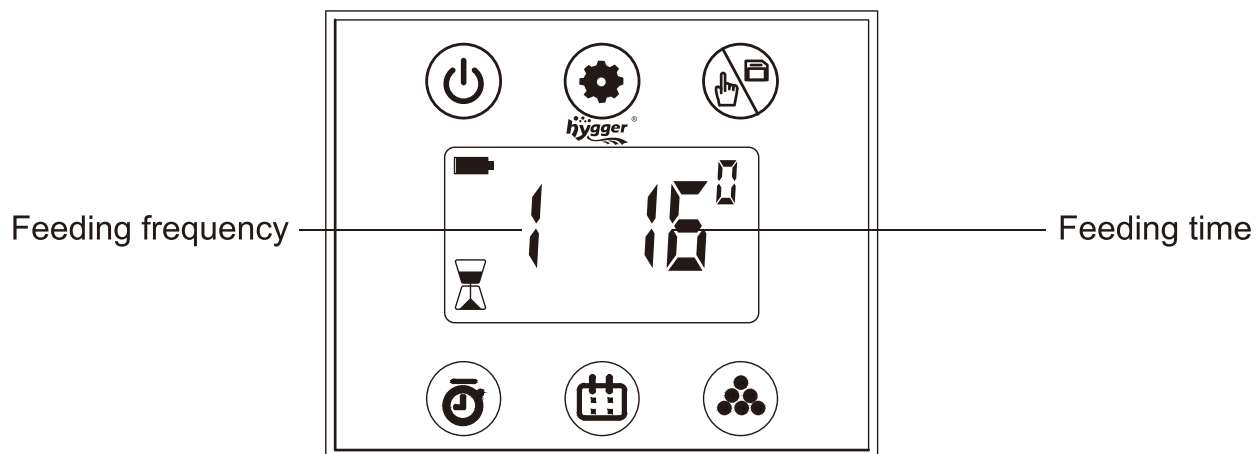
⏻ Power button: Install the battery and press the power button to start setting the feeder.

2) Local Time Setting

- ① Press "⌚" and then press "⚙️" to enter the time setting interface, and the four-digit display will flash.
- ② Press "⌚" to set the hour, and press "📅" to set the minute.
- ③ After the setting is complete, press "🚫" to save and exit the menu to return to the main interface.
- ④ Press "⌚" once in normal mode to check the set time.



3) Feeding Time Setting

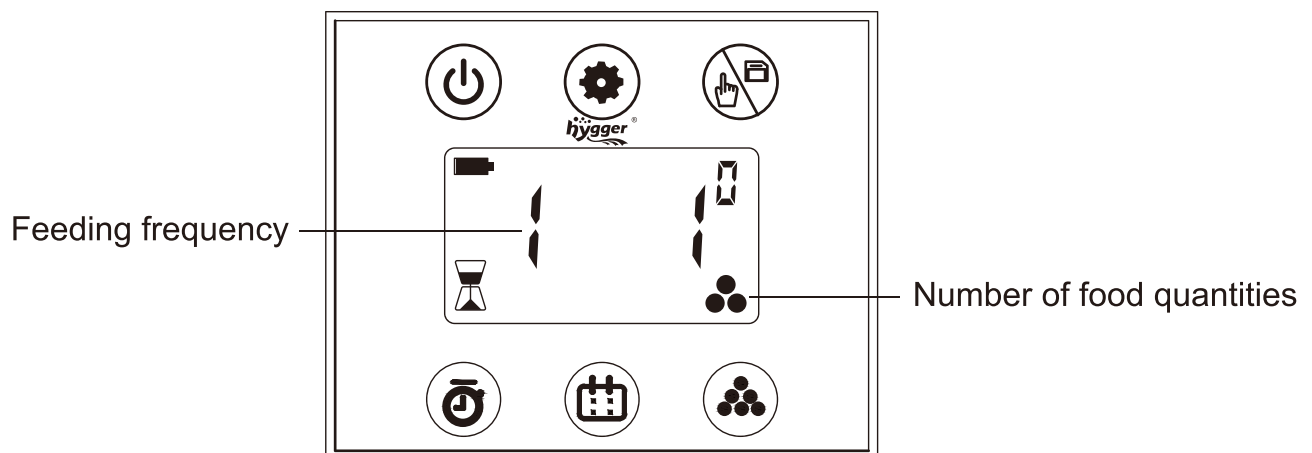


- ① Press "📅" to enter the feeding time setting interface.
- ② Press "⚙️" to set the feeding time for the first meal, and the two-digit display will flash ("--" indicates no feeding).
- ③ Press "📅" to set the hour, then press "⚙️" to set the feeding time for the next meal.
- ④ After setting, press "🚫" to save.
- ⑤ Press "📅" once in normal mode to check the feeding time set.

Please Note:

- ① Feeding time is on the hour.
- ② Up to 6 feeding times can be set.
- ③ Please set the feeding time clockwise.

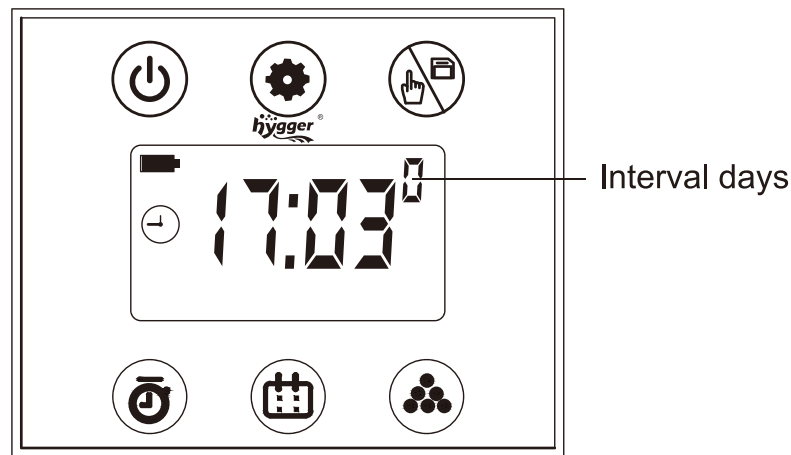
4) Food Quantity Setting



- ① Press "🍲" button to enter the interface to display the food quantity of each meal, the last digit on the screen will flash. Then, press "⚙️" button to enter the interface for setting the food quantity for each meal.
- ② Press "🍲" to set the food quantity for each meal, you can set up to 9 lattice food quantities and then press "⚙️" to set the next meal.
- ③ After setting, press "🚫" to save the setting and exit the menu.
- ④ Press "🍲" once in normal mode to check the food quantity Set.

Please Note: Each serving size for feeding is '1 lattice,' '-' means no feeding time is set.

5) Feeding Interval Setting



Press and hold "⚙️" for 3 seconds, and "Interval Days between feedings" will flash. Each time you press "⚙️", the value increases by 1 unit. The default setting is "0", and the interval can be set up to "7" days.

6) Manual Feeding

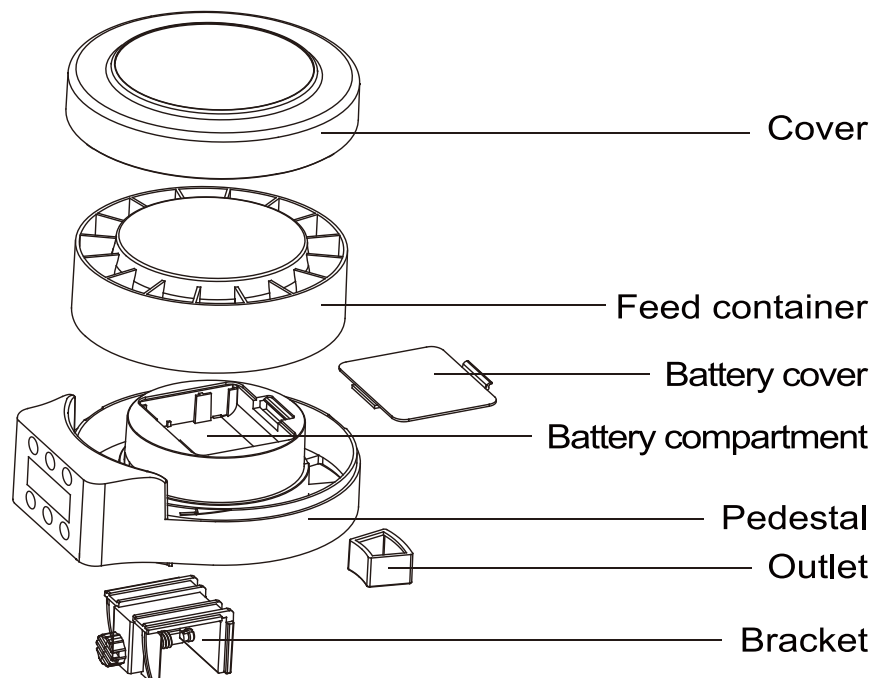
Press 🕒 to manual feeding in standby mode, each serving size for feeding is standardized to a single unit, known as 1 lattice

The interface shows "----" for one hour after a single daily meal, indicating that no more feedings are scheduled for today.

Please Note: If the feeder is dormant, press and hold 🕒 for 3 seconds to wake it up when you need to feed manually.

7. MAINTENANCE

1. This product is designed for indoor use only and should not be submerged in water.
2. When refilling fish food, clean out any residual powder from the container to prevent the Feed container from getting stuck due to moisture.
3. Clean and dry the food container regularly, ideally at least once a month, to prevent feed from clumping.
4. Do not rinse the food container with water.
5. Avoid touching the buttons with wet hands.



8. TROUBLESHOOTING

Problem	Reason	Solution
No display on control panel	Low battery	Replace the battery
	Internal connection cable is loose	Open the battery compartment and reinstall it
	The switch is off	Turn on the switch
Display but no response	The feed container gets stuck	Clean the feed container
